::::::: NEW ENTRY RULES! NEW DEADLINE! ::::::::

1. In response to numerous requests from non-UN filmmakers, Stories from the Field will now accept film entries from both UN and non-UN filmmakers that reflect any of the eight Millennium Development Goals. The goals are:
 - Eradicate extreme poverty and hunger
 - Achieve universal primary education
 - Promote gender equality and empower women
 - Reduce child mortality
 - Improve maternal health
 - Combat HIV/AIDS, malaria and other diseases
 - Ensure environmental sustainability
 - Develop a global partnership for development
2. Any film under 60 minutes that reflects one or more of the Millennium Development Goals may enter.
3. The Best Public Short award has been replaced by Best Public Film.
4. The deadline for all entries has been extended to January 20, 2006.
